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Retraction Note: Severe Viperidae envenomation complicated by a state of shock, acute kidney injury, and gangrene presenting late at the emergency department: a case report

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The authors have retracted this case report [1] because the head of the snake shown in Figure 1 and described as being that of a viper (*Echis ocellatus*) is identical to the head of a snake shown in Figure 1 of a different case report [2] where it was identified as being *Naja melanoleuca*, a member of the *Elapidae* family. The authors do not have records of the manufacturer and batch numbers of the 3 vials of anti-venom serum administered to the patient in [1]. All authors agree with this retraction.
